## FACILITIES AVAILABLE FOR SAFETY AND SECURITY OF WOMEN ON THE CAMPUS:

- a. **Safety and security:** 24X7 security is available through security guard on the campus as well as at Girls hostel. Two lady rectors and a separate security guard in shift are deputed at ladies' hostel. Separate pedestrian facility for boys and girls is provided. CCTV surveillance is available on the campus. Complaint box and contact numbers of Nirbhaya Police squad are displayed. 'Prevention of sexual harassment at workplace' and antiragging cell' is in working.
- b. **Counselling:** Counselling sessions are arranged by Principal and counselling committee at the initiation of first term. The faculty members inform all the students regarding various activities and empowerment schemes available, women rights, dress code, identity card, code of conduct etc. The cell organizes various gender awareness activities from time to time.
- c. **Common Rooms:** The college has provided 3 common rooms for girl students and one for women staff. There is separate reading room for girls at library.
- d. **Other facilities:** The college has provided RO drinking water, first aid box, fire extinguishers, Girls NCC, separate vehicle parking in front of girl's hostel, sports facility, women empowerment programs, Blood Hb checking and medical check-up camps, self-defence training programs are arranged frequently.

## **PROMOTION OF GENDER EQUITY**

The institute is a coeducation institute. We promote gender equity through organization of various programs and giving equal opportunities to the Girls and boys. It includes celebration of specific days namely Savitribai Phule Anniversary, Rajmata Jijau Anniversary, celebration of Samvidhan Din, Celebration of Rajarshi Shahu Anniversary. Equity is also promoted by organizing open competitions for boys and girls viz., rangoli, mehndi, elocution, essay writing, poem recitation competitions etc.
